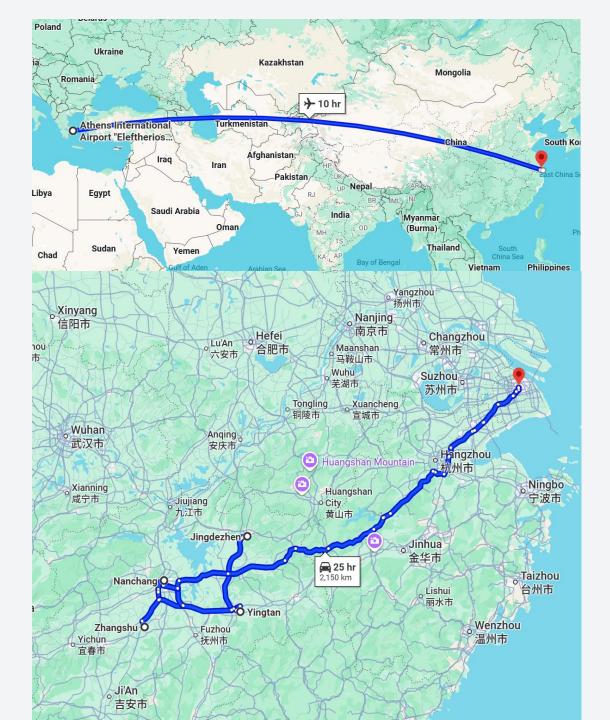
Why YES

The YES program is an integrated information hub that consolidates resources from numerous Chinese educational institutions, including all school levels across China's different regions, with a view to being an effective mechanism to help students from Overseas campuses to find their ideal overseas programs and opportunities in China. Participants in YES are able to gain cross-cultural competencies in a diverse range of academic settings with hands-on adventures, while engaging in valuable educational experiences that can earn credits.

What Can You Find In YES

The overall program includes short-term exchange programs, international summer school programs, summer/winter camp, semester-long/short term study programs, short-term internship programs, and international students foundation programs and youth forums, etc. Hosted by CEAIE, participating students are able to explore recent social, economic and scientific developments in China while revisiting the five thousand-year history of China and experiencing its unique cultural and geographical richness.

Jiangxi Province and JXUCM



Jiangxi Province

Jiangxi Province lies on the southern bank of the Yangtze River's lower and middle sections. It has an area of 166,900 sq km and a population of 39.66 million. Nanchang is the provincial capital.

Topography: Jiangxi is high in the south and low in the north. It is bordered by hills and mountains, the land generally sloping towards the Poyang Lake in the north. Hills and mountains account for 60% of the province's landmass.

Tourism: Jiangxi abounds in tourism resources. Nanchang, Jingdezhen, Jiujiang and Ganzhou are important sites of historic andculturalinterest. The Poyang Lake, China's largest fresh water lake,

offers a sight seldomseen elsewhere when cranes, during their southward migration, arrive in thousands in winter for food and shelters in lakeside reed marshes. All in all, Jiangxi has 450 tourism attractions.

JXUCM

Jiangxi University of Chinese

Since the founding in 1959,and especially since the start of reform and opening up more than 30 years ago, Jiangxi University of Chinese Medicine (JXUCM) has always adhered to the educational mission of "serving the development of traditional Chinese medicine, the local economic development, the allround social progress and the nation", and has promoted the school motto "Learning and Virtue, Devoting and Excellence"...

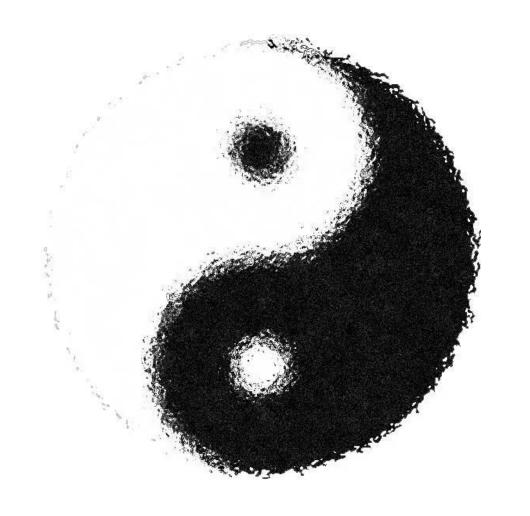
Covering an area of 2308 mu (i.e. 154 hectares), JXUCM has 23000 full-time students. There are 27 undergraduate programs at the university, including disciplines—medicine, management, social sciences and humanities. In the first-level discipline, **JXUCM** 2 authorized degree points and 4 doctorate authorized master degree points respectively. JXUCM has 3 national scientific research platforms and 46 research platforms at ministerial or provincial level.

JXUCM has been one of the first batch universities that are authorized to cultivate foreign students by the Ministry of Education. There have been more than 1600 students coming from Taiwan, Hongkong, Macao and more than 10 countries studying at the university. Meanwhile, the university has set up the long-term cooperation with research, medicine and education institutions from more than 20 regions and countries. Taking Chinese medicine education as the main body, JXUCM is adistinctive Chinese medicine university with the coordinated multi-disciplinary development and the combination involving production, teaching & research.

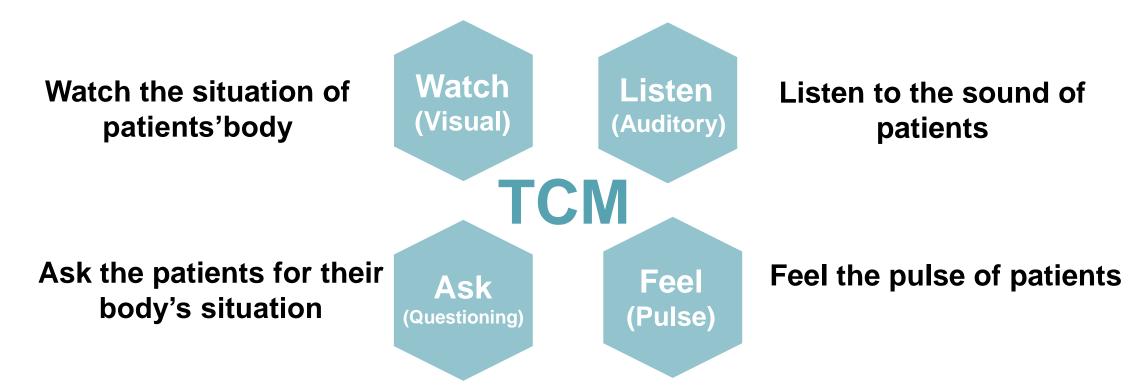
Tai Chi Culture Experience

Tai Chi-Art of the Harmony

The philosophical root of Tai Chi comes from the Yin-Yang theory in the I Ching (Book of Changes). Yin and Yang represent two fundamental forces in the universe—Yin (soft, still, dark) and Yang (hard, dynamic, bright)—which depend on and transform into each other, maintaining balance and harmony in the universe.



Overview of Traditional Chinese Medicine (Lecture)



Traditional Chinese medicine, Zhong Yi, is a therapy and a theory on how to stay healthy. Diagnosis in Zhong Yi comes from various forms of observation, including visual, auditory, olfactory, tactile and questioning. The doctor observes a patient's tongue, voice, inquires about the patient's habits and medical history, and feels the patient's pulse to make a diagnosis.

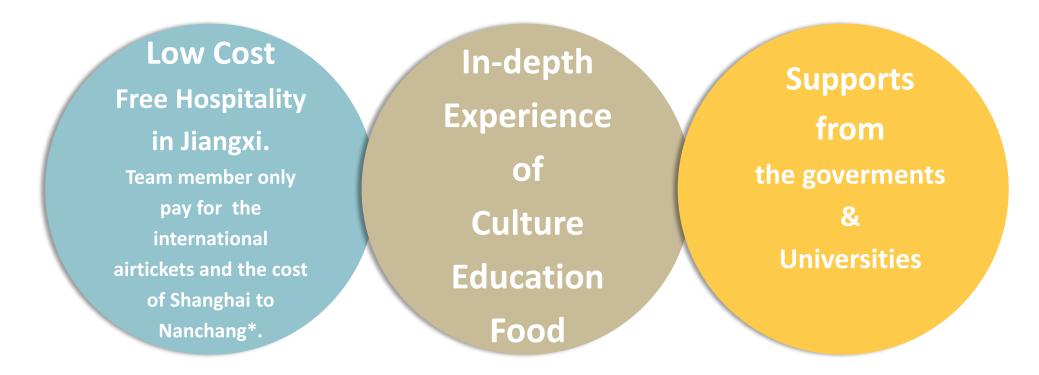
